

Requirements:

- Single-family dwellings
- Zoning R-1 or R-2 (see table at right)
- Permits required:
  - Zoning (one time)
  - Building (one time, see coop requirements)
  - Chicken permit (original, then annually)
- Coop required
  - 100 square feet maximum
  - 8 feet height maximum
  - In rear yard only
  - At least 25 feet from lot line
  - Building permit required
- Adjacent fence enclosed area optional
  - 120 square feet maximum
  - At least 25 feet from lot line
  - Chickens must be contained in coop or enclosed area
- Slaughter of chickens for person use is allowed on property
- Chicken keeping must be
  - Clean, sanitary, sound, usable
  - Free of rodents, vermin, objectionable odors or noise
- Owner responsible for confirming permitted use in any deed restrictions/covenants applicable
- Chickens and eggs for personal use only and may not be sold
- Public health requirements:
  - Keeping and handling shall be sanitary to prevent communicable diseases
  - Unusual illness or death of chickens shall be reported to the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection and the Town of Trenton
  - Town may order testing, quarantine, isolation, vaccination, humane euthanasia of ill chickens at the owner's cost
