

**Town of Trenton, Washington County, Wisconsin
Ordinance Z2026.03.03
Amending the Town Zoning Code to correct rule regarding animals allowed in CES-10**

WHEREAS, the Town of Trenton Board has authority to enact or amend town ordinances under Wis. Stats. §60.61(2), and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has reviewed sections of the current town zoning ordinance and found an incorrect limit within the code regarding animals allowed in CES-10; and

WHEREAS, the Town has duly noticed and held a public hearing before the Plan Commission on March 9, 2026 and before the Board on March 16, 2026, on the proposed zoning code amendment, following the procedures in Wis. Stats. §60.61(4); and

WHEREAS, at its March 9, 2026 meeting, the Plan Commission recommended approval of the changes to the town zoning code as detailed herein; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board determines that this Ordinance is in the best interests of the residents of the Town of Trenton.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town of Trenton Board hereby ordains that the Town of Trenton Zoning Code §380-34 is amended as follows:

Section 1. Amend §380-34 B(3)(a), as follows:

Replace: "maximum of 1 ½ animals per five acres"

With: "maximum of three animals per five acres"

Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall be effective upon publication or posting under applicable law.
