

## Minutes from the Town of Trenton Plan Commission Meeting

### Approve the Agenda:

It was moved by Joan Baumgartner and seconded by Dennis Kay to approve the Agenda with the following change: move item 11, West Bend Lakes Pavilion, up to follow item 7, Eickstedt shed approval. Voting in favor: 6. Opposed: 0.

### Approve the Minutes of the October 11, 2022 Plan Commission Meeting:

It was moved by Dennis Kay and seconded by Bob Roden to approve the Minutes of the October 11, 2022 Plan Commission Meeting. Voting in favor: 6. Opposed: 0.

### Architectural Approval, Shed in CES-10 Zoning – Eickstedt, 5742 CTH M:

### Architectural Approval, Pavilion Building, West Bend Lakes Golf & Recreation:

Recommendation to the Town Board – Ordinance Z2022-11-01, Rezoning Petition, Esselmann Trust:

Jeff Esselmann commented that the pump house would be taken down in the spring. It was moved by Joan Baumgartner and seconded by Ray Werhand to recommend approval of Ordinance Z2022-11-01. Voting in favor: 6. Opposed: 0.

Recommendation to the Town Board – Certified Survey Map Approval, Esselmann Trust:

It was moved by Scott Schweizer and seconded by Joan Baumgartner to recommend approval of the Esselmann Trust Certified Survey Map. Voting in favor: 6. Opposed: 0.

Reports:

Barb Davies reported that she would be starting work on a draft chicken ordinance. Following discussion about the possibility of numerous ways to calculate how many chickens should be allowed on properties zoned R1 and R2 residential, the conclusion was that application of the ordinance should be simple, allowing for 5 chickens on lots of at least one acre and zoned R1 or R2. Owners of larger lots could consider rezoning.

Joe Gonnering reported not much damage in the recent windstorm. Public Works employees are still cutting brush & trees.

Comments:

Ray Werhand asked about the progress on a property cleanup on Decorah Road, and details on a horse farm for sale on N. Oak Road. Dennis Kay commented on leaf burning/leaf disposal.
