

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: April 4, 2022, 5:00 PM

Location: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Chairman Joseph Gonnering, Supervisor Jeff Esselmann (via teleconference), Supervisor Ed Doerr (via teleconference), Clerk Cindy Komro, DPW Director Charles Schmidt.

Chairman Joseph Gonnering dispensed with the Pledge of Allegiance. Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 5:00 P.M.

1. Approve Minutes of Town Board Meetings of March 15, 2022:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the minutes of the Town Board meeting of March 15, 2022; Ed Doerr seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

2. Affidavit of Posting:

Chairman Gonnering read the affidavit of posting, that notice was properly posted prior to the meeting on the Town Bulletin Board and the Town official website and was also sent to the Washington County Daily News and WIBD Radio.

3. Comments and Questions from the Audience:

Cory Deruyter, 2263 Newark Drive commented that the speed limit signs were removed when Newark Drive was reconstructed and have not yet been replaced. Joe Gonnering agreed to contact the Town of Farmington.

Supervisor Jeff Esselmann reported that Waste Management has not yet responded to the request for the 2021 recycling tonnage numbers.

Supervisor Ed Doerr had nothing to report.

Chairman Joe Gonnering reported on a County Emergency Management meeting, on a Mid-Moraine Municipal Court meeting, on the Pat Ryan junk complaint status and on Wisconsin DOT funding for Newark Drive.

DPW Director Charles Schmidt reported on damage to the guardrail on Paradise Drive.


12. Payment of Bills:
