

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: April 19, 2022, 7:00 PM

Location: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Chairman Joseph Gonnering, Supervisor Jeff Esselmann, Supervisor Ed Doerr, Clerk Cindy Komro, Treasurer Nicole Cozzuli-Meer, DPW Director Charles Schmidt.

Chairman Joseph Gonnering asked those in attendance to stand and recite the Pledge of Allegiance. Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

1. Approve Minutes of Town Board Meetings of April 4, 2022:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the minutes of the Town Board meeting of April 4, 2022; Ed Doerr seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

2. Affidavit of Posting:

Chairman Gonnering read the affidavit of posting, that notice was properly posted prior to the meeting on the Town Bulletin Board and the Town official website and was also sent to the Washington County Daily News and WIBD Radio.

3. Comments and Questions from the Audience:

Tom Kempke, Village of Newburg resident, asked about allowing ATVs on town roads.

Jason Princl, 7012 Fairfield Drive, reported on a grass/debris fire on Sunday, April 17 at 7047 Shady Lane, adjacent to his property. The fire spread quickly and threatened nearby properties. The Newburg Fire Department responded to an emergency call. Three individuals required medical attention due to the smoke. Other neighbors were in attendance to report that this event was not isolated and has become habitual. Nicole Hiatt, 7036 Wingate Circle, asked whether the resident responsible would receive any consequences for the repeated behavior. Discussion followed.

8. Resolution 2022.04.02 Requesting State Legislature to Modify Levy Limits:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve Resolution 2022.04.02; Ed Doerr seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

9. Resolution 2022.04.03 Naming of Mapledale Road and Mapledale Drive:

Ed Doerr moved to approve Resolution 2022.04.03; Jeff Esselmann seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

10. North Church Road:

Chairman Joe Gonnering reported on road work on North Church Road.

11. Shady Lane:

Chairman Joe Gonnering reported on road work on Shady Lane.

12. Department Reports:

Treasurer Nicole Cozzuli-Meer reported on the annual dog licenses.

Clerk Cindy Komro reported on the Spring Election, the redistricting and on the Board of Appeals training materials.

DPW Director Charlie Schmidt reported on the damage done to the bridge.

Supervisor Jeff Esselmann reported on shouldering on Sand Drive.

Supervisor Ed Doerr reported on the weeds.

Chairman Joe Gonnering reported on DPW activity.


13. Payment of Bills:
