

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: January 17, 2023, 7:30 PM

Location: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Chairman Gonnering asked those in attendance to stand and recite the Pledge of Allegiance. Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:30 P.M.

1. Approve Minutes of Town Board Meeting of January 3, 2023:  
Ed Doerr moved to approve the minutes of the Town Board meeting of January 3, 2023; Jeff Esselmann seconded. Motion carried 3-0.
2. Affidavit of Posting:

Town Administrator/Clerk Cindy Komro reported that Washington County is offering pavement marking services in 2023.

15. Town Hall Furniture:

Town Administrator/Clerk Cindy Komro explained the need to dispose of certain furniture, including the conference table and an old desk.

16. Department Reports:

Director of Public Works Charlie Schmidt reported on the proposed road work for 2023.

Zoning Administrator Barbara Davies reported on the activity in the building and zoning departments, and on the upcoming proposed ordinance allowing chickens in R-1 and R-2 zoning on certain size lots.

Administrator/Clerk Cindy Komro reported on the Washington County Unit Meeting on January 30 at 7:00 p.m. at Addison Town Hall, on Harter's Lakeside Disposal and on property tax collections.

Supervisor Jeff Esselmann reported on resident calls regarding trash and recycling compliments for Harter's Lakeside Disposal and on a potential grant for electronics recycling.

Supervisor Ed Doerr had nothing to report.

Chairman Gonnering reported on resident calls regarding the new days of the week for trash and recycling curbside collection, and on the need to raze the property on Evergreen Drive.


17. Payment of Bills:
