



## **Town of Trenton & Advanced Disposal (formerly Veolia)**

The Town of Trenton has now switched from manual residential collection to a new automated trash and recycling collection. The new collection system provides enhanced convenience for residents and increased recycling capabilities. Recycling services will be performed on an every-other-week basis, the same day as the trash pickup.

Residents will be provided carts at no extra charge from Advanced Disposal. Carts will have different colored lids for each material. Automated pickup will require that all waste and recycling fit inside the carts with the lids closed for collection. Residents will no longer be permitted to place bags or small items curbside for pick up. **All items must fit into the carts. Bulk items that do not fit into the carts will NOT be accepted.**

Based on comments from residents, Advanced Disposal will offer an option to receive a smaller (64-gallon) cart. If you desire a smaller cart, you **MUST** notify Advanced Disposal **NO LATER THAN** April 15, 2013, by notifying Advanced Disposal's call center at 920-387-0987 between 7:30 – 4:30.

Please be aware of the following, if you choose the smaller carts:

- You will receive two 64-gallon carts (one for trash and one for recycling). Advanced cannot accommodate two different sized carts at one residence.
  - The current 95-gallon cart is 26" wide with a depth of 27" and a height of 48"
  - The 64-gallon cart is 24" wide with a depth of 23.75" and a height of 41.5"
- **IF at any time you change your mind and wish to switch back to the larger cart or you have not made your request in the timeline above, a cost of \$65 per cart will apply.**

In addition, Advanced has offered to provide a limited amount of "Tow-A-Bins" at a reduced cost. If you have a longer driveway that makes it difficult to drag your cart, please contact the Town Hall for more information.

Advanced Disposal understands that some residents have health issues that might make wheeling the bins to the curb difficult. Therefore, the company has a process by which a hardship exception may be available. If you believe you might satisfy the criteria for a hardship exception, please contact the Town Hall for more information. Hardship exceptions will be decided on a case-by-case basis.

The enhanced services provide a convenient and efficient option for trash and recycling needs. The new recycling cart will allow all recyclables to be placed in one convenient container, eliminating the need to separate bottles, cans, and plastics from paper and cardboard. The larger recycling cart will also make it easier to fit folded cardboard boxes and other large recyclables that proved difficult with the smaller crates. The simplest way to reduce trash cart collections is to utilize the recycling options as much as possible.
