

## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING – PETITION FOR CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Public Hearing will be held before the Plan Commission and the Town Board at the Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 STH 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095 at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, April 13, 2026. The Public Hearing will be held to accept public comments on an application submitted by Rob n Cin Farms, LLC.

In accordance with Town Zoning Ordinances, Section 380-14C, Subsection (13) Livestock facilities of 1,000 or more animal units, Rob-n-Cin Farms has petitioned the Town for a Conditional Use Permit to expand its existing livestock facility.

Upon the closure of any and all Public Hearings scheduled for Monday, April 13, a meeting of the Trenton Plan Commission shall be called to order, and the amendment shall be addressed per the agenda.
